



**JANUARY 6, 2026**

The council of the City of Glasco met in regular session Tuesday, January 6, 2025, at 7:00pm at City Hall.

Mayor Carl Shrontz called the meeting to order at 7:00pm

Public Comments, petitions, requests, suggestions, etc.

- Rachel Moore – Glasco Library Director requests approval for new board member Austin Gydensen effective at their February meeting to replace Brenda McDuffee on the board as she is now a City of Glasco councilmember
  - Motion to approve new member Austin Gydensen by Dan Darnall, second by Haley Davidson – all others in favor
- Complaint sent by email – Trees on property on corner of Railroad & 3<sup>rd</sup>
  - Council agrees diseased/dead trees should to be removed per city ordinance 708-2025

Ordinance Control Report – Terry Lambert:

- Provided list of notices given to council
  - Mr. Lambert was asked to issue warnings for residents that have dogs in town without leashes.
  - Council requested Mr. Lambert check all alleyways to make sure they are clear of vehicles and other obstructions.
  - Council requested Mr. Lambert to check on the car body and construction debris in the alleyway behind East Main Street.



#### Public Works Director Report – Kevin Peterson:

- Johnson Service Company came and cleaned the 2 North sewer lines all were good except for one area by The Nicol Home.
  - Mr. Peterson showed council the images and video from Johnson's visit of the cast iron pipe that is mostly restricted and has a very slow flow
    - Council approves cleaning
  - Mr. Peterson also showed footage in the sewer East of The Nicol Home where a piece of equipment is stuck at 113.5 feet down from sewer main access hole
    - Prices are \$450/hour – full day fee \$4,500
    - Council approves removal
- Lights at fire station have been replaced by KJ Electric and are all working properly
- New power pole on Railroad was installed, removing power line from a roof
- Would like to start looking for quotes for a new mower. The Hustler has been having issues with exhaust smoking at start up.
  - Council requested Mr. Peterson to get bid to review at February meeting from local dealers: suggested Ackerman's, Hometown Outdoor Power, Sankey Auto Center
- A new water meter for well house was installed and working properly
- Truck Route proposal provided images of the route, but the road needs to be improved by the county as it is not easy to travel during wet weather
- Would like to cut the trees down by the Glasco sign on Cemetery Road and plant new ones
  - Council approves tree removal
- Still needing stump grinder – currently watching an auction
  - Council approves purchase bids up to \$2,500
- Brad Smith will be coming next week to clean more at the Travel Center
- Would like to purchase a 4' bucket for the backhoe – offered quotes to council
  - Table till next meeting
